

SUNRAY SUPERSTARS LEAGUE EXPECTATIONS – 2009/2010

- 1) Please arrive on time for practice and ready to bowl every Saturday – with the \$8.00 weekly fee. This is a time commitment that bowlers and parents alike must be willing to make and to honor throughout the season.
- 2) Rules of bowling etiquette, sportsmanship, and courtesy will be communicated regularly and are to be observed at all times.
- 3) Bowlers and spectators are responsible for leaving their area in the same condition in which it was found. This would include: returning all house balls to the racks, returning all rental shoes to the bowling desk with the laces untied, removing of all trash from on and under scoring tables AND concourse tables behind your pair of lanes, and returning bar chairs to the bar. **BOTH TEAMS** on a pair of lanes are expected to work together to clean up the lanes *before either team leaves*.
- 4) Communication with the coaches (kept confidential if requested) regarding the nature of any extended absence (due to illness, injury, conflict with another activity schedule, etc.) is necessary to guarantee a return to your original team. (Re-establishment of bowler's average *may* be necessary). Bowlers absent for 4 consecutive competitive weeks with no explanation to the coaches (does not include "fun days") will be moved onto a substitution list automatically and the team will be given a "vacant" bowler score to fill out the team roster.
- 5) Seating at the scoring tables is for junior bowlers only - Minimal exceptions will be allowed for parents of younger bowlers in our prep division. Family members and friends may arrange seating on the carpeted area of the concourse. Please return all chairs to the location from where you took them.
- 6) No alcohol consumption is allowed on the concourse behind junior bowlers during ANY USBC Youth-Sanctioned event.
- 7) Prebowling is a benefit granted by the coaches of the junior league and will be permitted for regular weekly competition after establishment of averages, **ONLY** with the purchase of prebowl cards, and is not to be used as an ongoing way to avoid regular Saturday morning bowling. Prebowling is not necessary for scheduled fun days but must be pre-arranged to have a member of the coaching staff present for roll-off or league championship events. Postbowling is not an option.
- 8) The game room is off-limits to junior bowlers until completion of your shift.
- 9) Although it is understood that situations do come up occasionally where a parent/guardian must leave the bowling center for a period of time, the junior bowling program is not intended to be a regular drop off point for our younger bowlers. Parents/guardians are encouraged to stay with the bowlers and support their efforts throughout the morning and throughout the season.
- 10) Cell phones, Ipods, and other personal electronic devices are **NOT** part of the sport of bowling. Because they tend to be a distraction to the flow of the bowling activities, please do not use them in the seating area. If you *must* make a phone call a bowler must leave the seating area between turns – but may not leave the building. If spotted in use in the seating area by any coach or the bowler does not return in time to bowl his or her next turn, he/she will be given a zero score in the most recent frame either in progress or last completed.
- 11) Violation of expectations by bowlers and/or parents may at the discretion of the coaching staff result in the suspension or expulsion of a junior bowler from the league.
