Registration is open to bowlers who have not turned 20 years of age as of August 1, 2009.

Bowl 3 games per shift every Saturday / Sorry! NO BUMPERS

4 divisions of competition (dependent upon established team average):

North (formerly Preps) – team averages of 525 or less

South (formerly Juniors) – team averages of 500 - 700

East (formerly Majors) – team averages of 600 – 800

West (new this year as Senior Majors) – team averages 750 or higher

8:00 shift (Mixed South/East/West Divisions)

(3-Person Teams Maximum) Practice starts at 7:50; Announcements and Bowling at 8:00

NOTE: Pending results of Sign-Up Day, We may not be able to offer this shift.

9:00/9:30 shift (North, South, East, and West Divisions)

(5-Person Teams Maximum) Practice starts at 9:20; Announcements and Bowling at 9:30

(pending on-time completion of the 8:00 shift, if offered)

NOTE: If there are not adequate sign-up levels for a viable 8:00 Shift, this shift will start at 9:00

Fee Schedule per Bowler – All Fees Are Non-Refundable:

Sanction - **\$17.00/one time yearly** – **required at sign up** (goes to state and national USBC registrations)

League Participation Fee - **\$10.00/per bowler for 1 shift or \$15.00/per bowler for 2 shifts (IF 2 shifts become available)/one time yearly** – used to fund year-end trophies and pizza party plus special events during the season

Lineage - **\$8.00/weekly** – 3 games, includes shoes and bowling ball rental if needed

Several optional “fun days” events during the season

Multiple tournaments promoted during the season offering opportunities to win college scholarship money – including our signature tournament weekend in Duluth in the Spring!

Year-end team awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place

Year-end individual awards for high game, high series (scratch and handicap), and most improved

Bowler of the Week recognition for highest over-average game
