Did you know?

- We offer discounts to schools and school related functions? In many cases we offer up to 50% off or more to every school.
- We have a FULL teacher's curriculum about bowling. We have the teacher's guidebook and mini bowling kits with balls, pins and lanes all free of charge. The Bowling Proprietors Association of Minnesota (BPAM) and the Bowling Proprietors Association of America (BPAA) have developed an easy-to-use, easy-to-learn curriculum that builds mathematic skills, hand-eye coordination and many others areas of child development. - Students that bring in their report cards with A's and B's are given free games of bowling.
